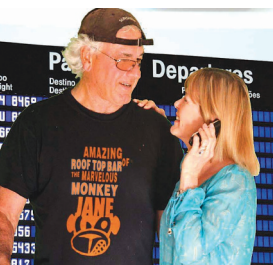


**Staying in touch via your mobile phone overseas** can be very expensive if you use your Australian SIM card. Mobile carriers use global roaming so you can continue to make and receive calls abroad, but the costs are extremely high and you might get a shock when you return home to a huge mobile phone bill. TravelSIM is the solution to this as it is a SIM card for international travel.



Australian tourists don't have many options when it comes to using their mobile phones overseas. They either buy a local pre-paid SIM card from a local telecommunications company, an option that has many unknowns, or just keep their Australian SIM card and then get hit with a huge global roaming bill when they return home.

There's now a solution to this problem that enables you to avoid high global roaming costs, called TravelSIM. It is a SIM card designed specifically for using overseas and in most of the 153 countries covered it will dramatically reduce your mobile call costs. It is the cheapest way to use your mobile phone overseas and it is very easy to use – just swap your normal sim card with TravelSIM when you travel.

Most people don't even realise they pay to receive calls on their Australian mobile when they are overseas. If that is not bad enough, calling out with your normal mobile service is very expensive.

Calling Australia from your TravelSIM-equipped mobile phone in Britain will cost you just 83c\* a minute – far less than Optus, Telstra or Vodafone, whose rates range from \$2.74\* to \$3.19\* a minute. Receiving calls is also cheaper: Britain is actually one of 60 countries where incoming calls are free on a TravelSIM.

Your TravelSIM will come with its own number and country code. It's particularly good value if you are going to multiple countries, because you don't need to buy a local SIM card at each location.

Just like other pre-paid SIM cards, TravelSIM gives you a reassuring level of control over your holiday spending. The \$49.95 TravelSIM Starter Kit includes \$5 of call credit and you can add to your balance any time via the internet, over the phone or from the mobile phone menu.

The great thing about TravelSIM is that it is more than just an international SIM card; it is the essential communications tool for international travel, because it also provides you with a human personal translator, on hand 24 x 7, to help you communicate in over 178 languages. Friends and family can also

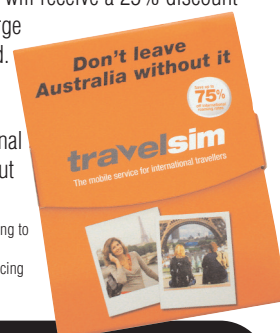
contact you via free web based sms directly to your TravelSIM mobile.

TravelSIM also has international data roaming on its GPRS service which is perfect for sending and receiving emails whilst travelling overseas.

To use TravelSIM you must make sure that your mobile phone is not locked to your carrier and that your mobile phone will work in the countries you are traveling to.
